# What challenges do we face today?



Since its inception in 1983, Agape has restored the lives of nearly **half a million** individuals.



- Reduced recidivism rates
- Changed lives
- Made families and communities better and stronger.
- Instilled a renewed spirit of hope, endurance, and self-sufficiency in thousands.



In 2018-19 alone, we had over **80,000** client encounters but our current infrastructure poses major constrictions.

**We are operating at full capacity, and our waiting list continues to grow.**

# What is the solution?



Agape is responding to this dire need with a **\$15 million** expansion. The expansion means new and improved facilities, more services and more staff.

## Key highlights of the Agape Village Health Center:

- Increase capacity from **1,000** to **2,500** receiving outpatient weekly services
- Residential inpatient capacity will be increased from **62-beds** to **141-beds**
- A new clinic & wellness medical center, educational and vocational center, supported housing cottages, a preschool/daycare center, gathering spaces and expansive courtyard
- Staffing will double from **150** to **330**
